READING FROM THE EPISTLES

1 Peter 4:1-5, 7

<sup>1</sup>Since therefore Christ suffered in the flesh, arm yourselves with the same way of thinking, for whoever has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin,<sup>2</sup> so as to live for the rest of the time in the flesh no longer for human passions but for the will of God.<sup>3</sup> For the time that is past suffices for doing what the Gentiles want to do, living in sensuality, passions, drunkenness, orgies, drinking parties, and lawless idolatry.<sup>4</sup> With respect to this they are surprised when you do not join them in the same flood of debauchery, and they malign you;<sup>5</sup> but they will give account to him who is ready to judge the living and the dead.

<sup>7</sup>The end of all things is at hand; therefore be self-controlled and sober-minded for the sake of your prayers.

Q: *What is sanctification?*

A. *Sanctification is the work of God's free grace, whereby we are renewed in the whole man after the image of God, and are enabled more and more to die unto sin, and live unto righteousness.*

Matthew 5:27-32

<sup>27</sup>"You have heard that it was said, 'You shall not commit adultery.'<sup>28</sup> But I say to you that everyone who looks at a woman with lustful intent has already committed adultery with her in his heart.<sup>29</sup> If your right eye causes you to sin, tear it out and throw it away. For it is better that you lose one of your members than that your whole body be thrown into hell.<sup>30</sup> And if your right hand causes you to sin, cut it off and throw it away. For it is better that you lose one of your members than that your whole body go into hell.

<sup>31</sup>"It was also said, 'Whoever divorces his wife, let him give her a certificate of divorce.'<sup>32</sup> But I say to you that everyone who divorces his wife, except on the ground of sexual immorality, makes her commit adultery, and whoever marries a divorced woman commits adultery.
